Submit a copy to the Department Administration in 415 Lehman Hall, keeping the original with these instructions for yourself.
2. During the program-filing period of your semester as a senior, add the courses you completed successfully as a junior.
3. After your advisor has initialed your report, give it to the Department Administrator. You must do this before the last day of program filing!
