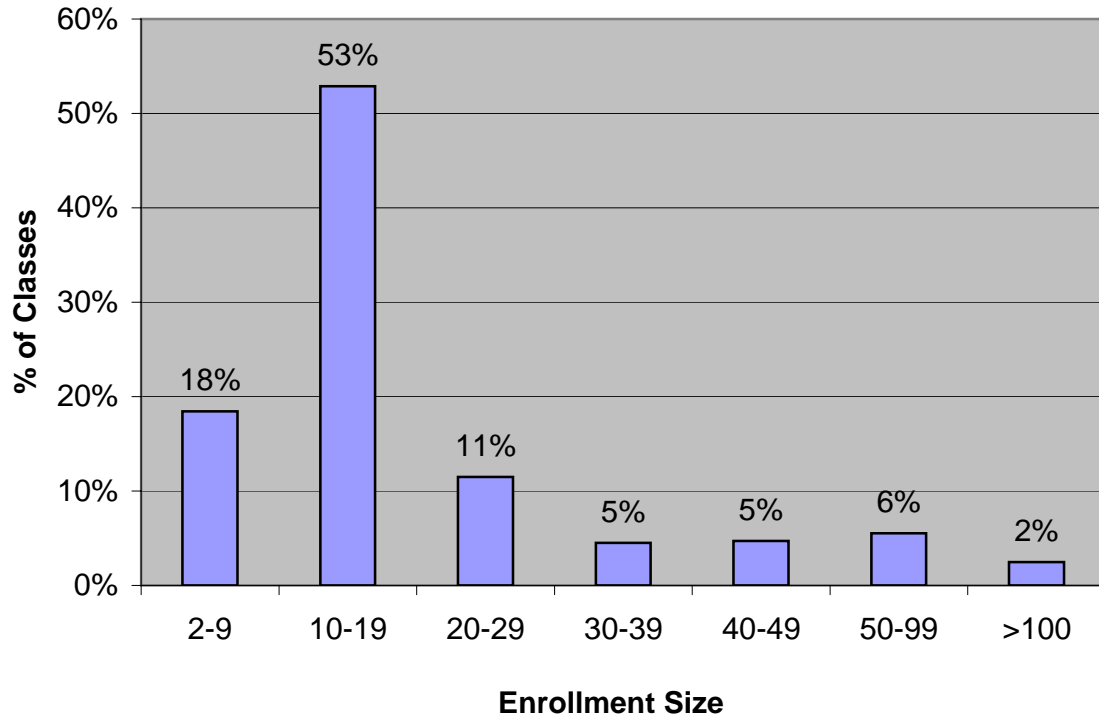

Barnard/Columbia Partnership

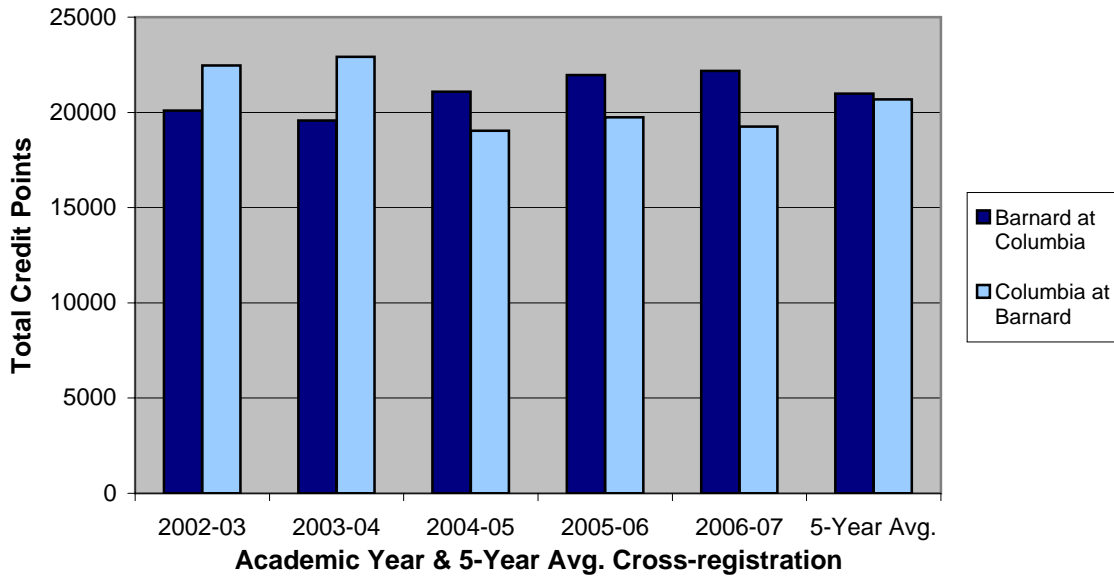
Barnard College is an independent affiliate of Columbia University. The relationship provides benefits for both institutions.

- Barnard Faculty have access to various Columbia apartments

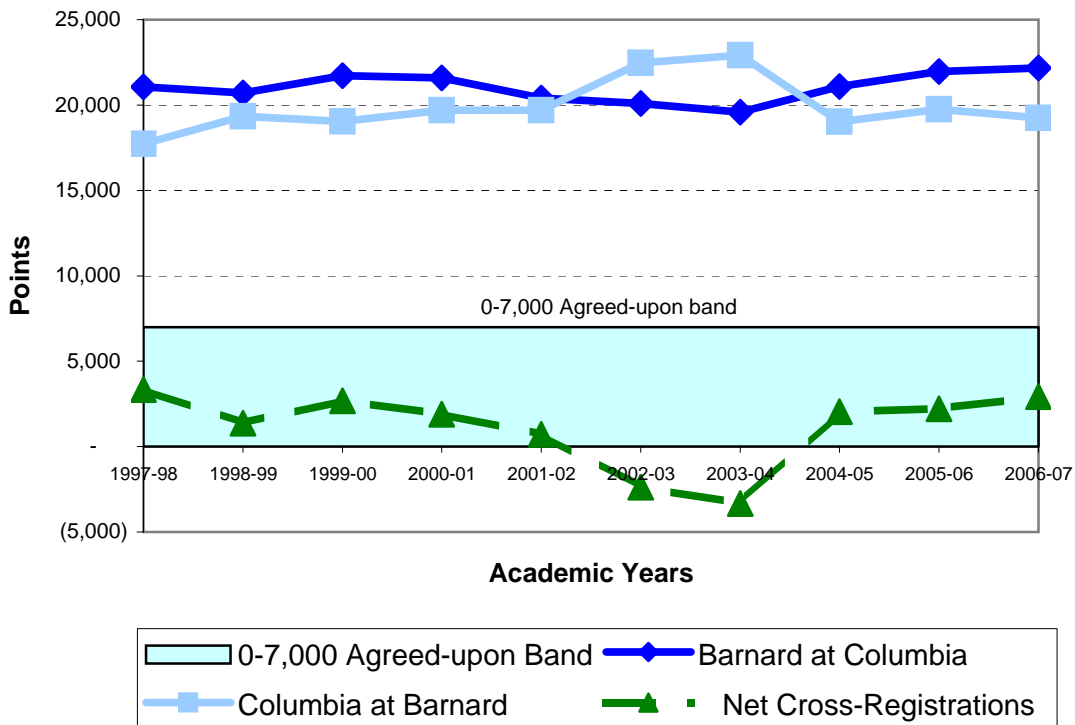

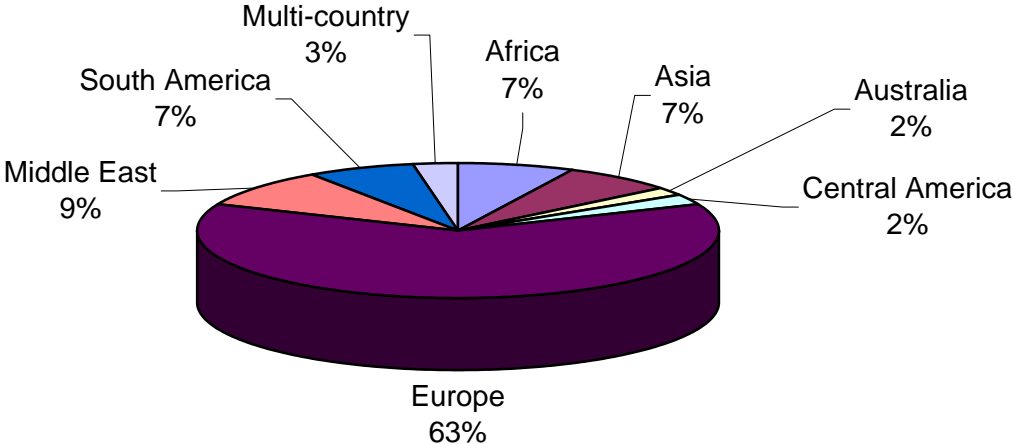

Study Abroad Destinations by Region, 2007-08



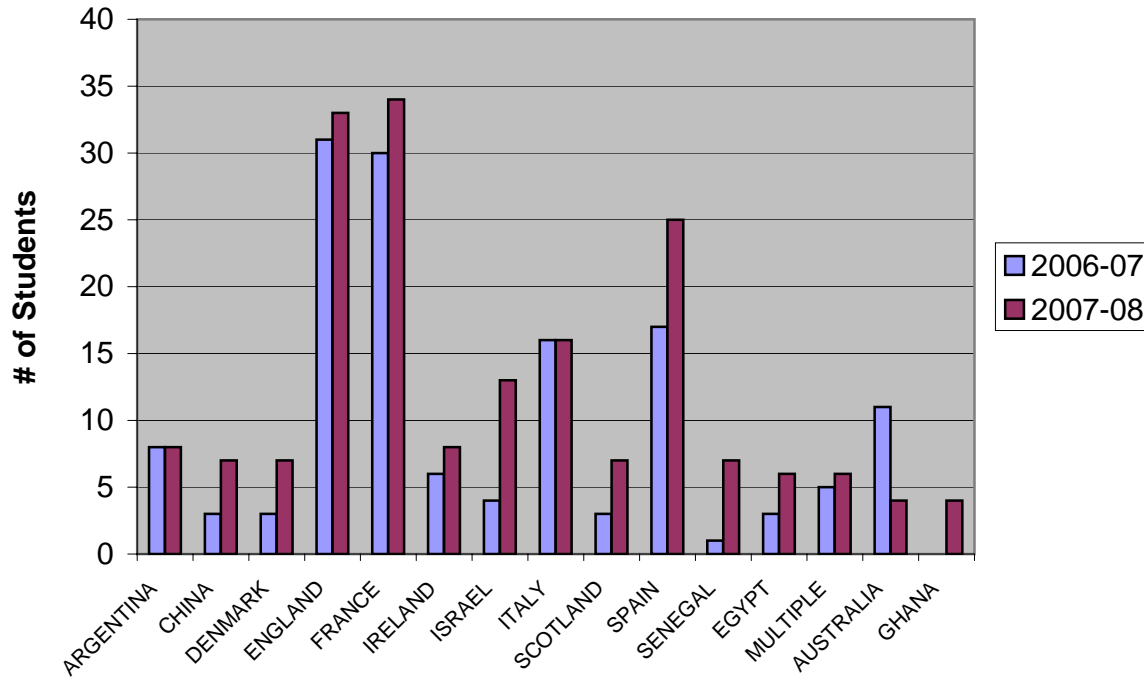

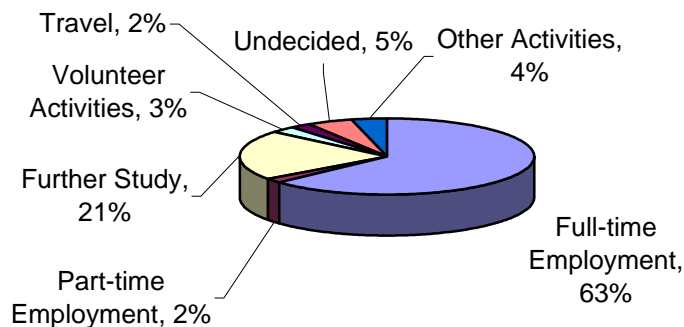

Results from the 2008 Senior Survey...

- 63% planned for full-time employment
- 2% planned for part-time employment
- 17% planned to attend graduate or professional school full-time
- 1% planned to attend graduate or professional school part-time
- 3% planned to pursue additional undergraduate coursework
- 3% planned to participate in volunteer activities
- 3% planned to travel
